

Raymond Scott wields his baton this evening as his eighteen-piece orchestra provides the dance music for the annual Junior Promenade.

Ranking among the first ten of the nation, his latest band has been currently billed with the more exclusive hotels and ballrooms in Chicago, St. Louis, New York City, Philadelphia, and San Francisco. They are now making a tour throughout the east at college dances with great success.

Mr. Scott himself is a composer of note. Among his more than 150 works are "Twilight in Turkey," "The Toy Trumpet," "In a Magic Garden," and "Huckleberry Duck." He wrote the score for the famous money-making musical comedy, "Lute Song," ring Mary Martin of radio and screen fame in a Chinese setting.


