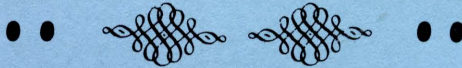


DIRECTOR'S NOTE:

Twelfth Night or What You Will is considered by many critics and scholars to be one of Shakespeare's greatest comedies. Written in 1601 or 1602, this bright piece is set in Illyria, a "high fantastical" land where fantasy and reality are readily exchanged in one giddy round after another.

Shakespeare employs two plots in this work. The one is based on the separated twins, Viola and Sebastian, who, while they think each other dead, cause no end of confusion as they make their way about Illyria. The other involves the gulling of the Puritanical Malvolio at the hands of the merry pranksters, Maria, Sir Andrew Aguecheek, Sir Toby Belch and Feste, the Lady Olivia's fool.

Scenes of mistaken identity, drunken buffoonery and ridiculous devices abound in this mad and merry comedy. Shakespeare deftly combines the lavish, extravagant poetry of Orsino and Olivia and their courts with the lively, rough-house fun of Sir Toby and his gang of roustabouts. Orsino is fooled, Olivia is fooled, Sir Andrew is fooled and Malvolio is fooled in this dizzying world called Twelfth Night.

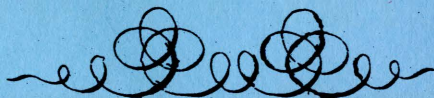



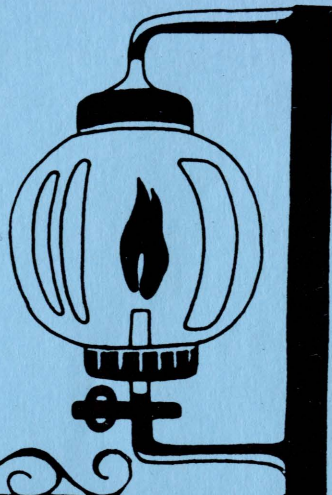
