In Georges Feydeau's turn-of-the-century farcical masterpiece, Yvonne Chandebise has "a flea in her ear," a nagging suspicion that her husband, Victor Emmanuel, is unfaithful. She concocts a clever ploy to entrap him at an infamous Parisian hotel and unwittingly sets in motion a mad comedy of disguises, mistaken identities, clandestine assignations, misplaced but explosive jealousies, and attempted murder. Directed by guest artist Brendan Byrnes, *A FLEA IN HER EAR* opens on Thursday, November 1, and runs through Sunday, November 4, 2001. Performances are at 8:00 PM, except for Sunday, which is a 2:00 PM matinee.
