## Judge's Biographies

### Eric Bilodeau

Eric Bilodeau is the Co-Founder and current Director of Programming for the Providence Children's Film Festival, which is going into its 8th year. Eric's past positions have included Director of Programming at the Newport International Film Festival, the Cable Car Cinema & Cafe, Bristol Cinemas, the Castle, and Meadowbrook Cinemas.

### Shawn Quirk

Shawn Quirk is an independent filmmaker, artist and scholar who has directed a number of short films and short documentaries. His film *Ouroboros* won the Audience Choice Award at the Spokane International Film Festival in 2008 and his film *The Coast* premiered at the Cannes Film Festival in 2010. After receiving his Bachelors of Science in Film Production from Boston University, Shawn then went on to work as a teaching assistant at the New York Film Academy at Harvard University. Shawn became a part of the Flickers team in the Fall of 2011, and is now the Program Director for Flickers and oversees the Rhode Island International Film Festival and the Vortex Sci-Fi, Fantasy, and Horror Film Festival. Shawn has been a guest lecturer in both film and French language studies courses at a number of Universities including Dartmouth College, Harvard University, RISD, and UMass Boston. Currently, he is pursuing his MFA from Lesley University.

### Michael Siegel

Michael Siegel holds a PhD in Modern Culture and Media from Brown University and has taught film history, media theory, and filmmaking at Brown, Rhode Island School of Design, and Clark University. He has published essays on the work of Roberto Rossellini, Michelangelo Antonioni, Dario Argento, and Tony Scott. He is currently Special Assistant to the President for Communications at Rhode Island School of Design.
