PAULA HUNTER AND DANCERS TO PERFORM AT PROVIDENCE COLLEGE

Paula Hunter and Dancers will be performing at the Blackfriars Theatre on December 5, 1986 at 8:00 p.m. as part of the Blackfriars Performing Arts Series at Providence College.

The company performs the choreography of Paula Hunter whose dance background includes classical ballet and the Cunningham modern dance technique. Besides presenting her works throughout the northeast, Paula Hunter has taught dance at Hamilton College, Brown University, and is currently on the faculty of Holy Cross College.

Her choreography can be described as making "you feel as if you've crossed into a time zone where human motion follows laws you've never learned and may never understand." Her style of choreography uses very complex rhythms and patterns and melts abstract movement with everyday gestures to create very technically exciting dances.
