Blackfriars Dance Concert

Providence College's Department of Theatre, Dance and Film presents the *Blackfriars Dance Concert*, to be performed by members of the Providence College Dance Company on 20 November and 21 November 2015.

The concert will feature works by several visiting artists including Danielle Davidson, renown dance artist and choreographer for various companies and colleges such as Compagnie Danse and Brown University; William Evans, owner and choreographer of Bill Evans Dance Company and full-time professor and Dance Artist in Residence, Palladino School of Dance, Dean College, Franklin, Massachusetts; Adrienne Hawkins, Artistic Director of Impulse Dance Company and Co-Artistic Director of Bass-Line; and Eva Marie Pacheco, Owner and Artistic Director of the Providence Ballet School. Light design will be done by G. Ben Swope.

Providence College faculty members will also contribute to the concert including Betsy Miller who will perform a solo in the production and Dr. Wendy Oliver, who has choreographed "Shapes of Matisse, a piece based on Henri Matisse's cut-outs, set to original music by Mike Kregler of the Providence College Music Department. Additionally, Shura Barishnikov of Providence Festival Ballet and the Trinity/Brown MFA program of will perform a duet choreographed by Heidi Henderson.

The production will be under the direction of Dr. Oliver, who heads the Dance Company of 24 students, ranging from first year students to seniors. The performance will consist of a variety of dance styles.
