The Providence College Dance Company will present its Fall Dance Concert on Friday, Nov. 17 at 7:30 PM, and Sat. Nov. 18 at 2 PM. The concert will be held in the Angell Blackfriars Theatre in the Smith Center for the Arts on the PC campus.

Guest choreographers for fall 2018 include Eva Marie Barney, Ali Brodsky, Cayley Christoforou, William Evans, and Kathleen Nasti. Barney runs Providence Ballet, and in addition to the contemporary ballet work she is setting on the PC Dance Company, she will be presenting a duet on two of her company members. Ali Brodsky, independent artist, will also perform a modern solo on the program. Cayley Christoforou of Salem, Mass. will present a contemporary piece. William Evans' dance is based on vintage jazz dance as well as tap dance, and is set in the big band era of the 1930s and 40s. PC choreographer Wendy Oliver's piece will feature rolling office chairs and light orchestral music of the 1950s.

The PC Dance Company includes 24 dancers ranging from first year students to seniors. These students take a company class together each week from some of the choreographers listed above. The company is fortunate to have the opportunity to work with this excellent group of artists.
