IMPORTANT NOTE: This play requires a cast of at least 25 actors, singers and dancers. All principal roles require acting skills and most require vocal skills. However, there will be roles for actors whose primary focus is not singing, singers who do not dance and dancers who do not want speaking parts. If you have skills in one of these areas but not others, there will still be an opportunity for you to be cast. Please come to the audition no matter what your strength is. If you consider yourself a singer, bring music; accompaniment will be provided. If singing is not your strength, you may sing any song you are comfortable with.
