Louisa May Alcott's Little Women

Providence College's Department of Theatre, Dance and Film presents **Louisa May Alcott's Little Women**, adapted by Mary G. Farrell and Caolan Madden, directed by Providence College faculty member, Mary G. Farrell.

In this version of the much-loved story of the March family, the author herself appears as the catalyst to bring her characters to life. Scenes of Jo, Meg, Beth, and Amy, and their circle of friends and relatives in their 19th century New England home give us insight into the upbringing that led Louisa Alcott to write a book based on her own experiences. Between scenes, traditional music of the Civil War period will be performed by live musicians.

Little Women will open with three performances on the weekend of March 26th, and continue with three performances two weeks later on the weekend of April 9th. Costume design will be by resident faculty member David Costa-Cabral, lighting design will be by Tim Cryan of New York, who has worked with the department for several productions over the last two years.
