Ordering Tickets by Mail

Buying Tickets at the Box Office

The Blackfriars Box Office is open from 1-5pm weekdays two weeks prior to each production. The box office is also open two hours prior to curtain on all performance days. The box office is located just off the rotunda on the first floor of Harkins Hall on the campus of Providence College.

Making Telephone Reservations

Tickets for all Blackfriars performances may be reserved by telephone. The box office will hold unpaid ticket reservations for up to three days. To make reservations for a Blackfriars performance call 401.865.2218.

Ticket Prices

Ticket prices for most productions are \$7.00 regular admission, \$5.00 seniors and PC employees, and \$3.00 for all students. Curtain times are 8pm on Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays, and 2pm for Sunday matinees. All tickets for Friars Cell student productions are \$3.00. Dance Concerts staged in Slavin Center are presented free of charge.
