This is an announcement regarding the third installation of the Theater, Dance and Film Department's Creative Writer's Festival, taking place on March 19<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm in the Smith Center for the Arts.

We are reaching out to faculty to encourage your students to participate in the Creative Writer's Festival and gain interactive and unconventional strengths within their liberal arts disciplines. We ask that you please read this information allowed to your classes or encourage them to seek more information about the event.

The Creative Writer's Festival is a student-driven, interactive experience of writing, directing and performing original works in creative methods and spaces. Students of all majors and abilities are invited to write and submit original pieces of fiction, short plays, monologues, short stories, essays, screen plays, poems, radio plays, original songs, etc. and engage in the informal, fun, not-so-standard practices of theater and performance. Students may choose to participate in the festival as writers or may decide to help direct and stage, stage manage or perform in a submitted piece. This is our third year of this production and we have been watching it grow in size each time.
