


## French comedy, The Imaginary Invalid, to be presented over two weekends

Providence College's Department of Theatre, Dance, and Film will present its first play of the academic year, Moliere's The Imaginary Invalid, on the weekends of Oct. 31 to Nov. 2 and Nov. 7 to 9 in the Angell Blackfriars Theatre of the Smith Center for the Arts.

Adapted by Miles Malleson, this comedy is set in 17th-century France and centers around Monsieur Argan, who acts outrageously, dragging his family through his hypochondriacal

woes and trying to marry off his daughter to a medical student to save money on his pharmacy bills.



Friday and Saturday performances are at 8:00 p.m., and the Sunday matinees are at 2:00 p.m. Tickets are \$13 for general admission, \$9 for senior citizens, and \$5 for students.
