- Please note that this policy only applies to students at this time.
 - a. **Cast & Crew:**
 - i. Pick up a voucher from your Stage Manager, Grace Dolan
 - b. **Work-Study Employees in TDF:**
 - i. Pick up a voucher from Jimmy Calitri or your supervisor, in the TDF Office
 - ii. If you are a work-study employee and a cast or crew member max number of comp tix is still 2.
- Please note:
 - **Vouchers are not tickets.** You must reserve comps for a specific performance in order to use them. Your tickets are not automatically reserved.
 - **Complimentary tickets are not available without a voucher.**
 - You may use your voucher for tickets for friends or family, but **you** need to place the Box Office order.
 - Voucher/ticket exchange is subject to availability.
 - With this system, complimentary tickets are no longer available over the phone for students.

Please note: If you reserve complimentary tickets and later realize you can no longer use them, please let the Box Office know – right up until curtain time. We will then be able to release your seats for sale.
