Providence April 20th 1839

Dr. Cannon? Dear Sir: I thought I would
write you and let you know how I was getting
along. I am now strong enough to bear my weight
on my foot, but the proud flesh is not all gone
there is now seven places on my leg & foot &
it is all healed except those places they have been
putting something on to them to eat it out, such
as burnt alum &c. Dr. Potter & some about
letting it go so long & not putting something on to
eat it out. Doctor I want you to write me how
you are getting along & how much cloth you are
getting ~~along~~ off & how they are getting along down
stairs, Neither Barden or Potter have been here
since I came home, & I have not heard from
them & I don't know whether they will want me
or not. Tell Tommy that I have got a crystal
in his watch. Tell them all how I do & do for
me. Tell Romanda I will fetch her up
something towards keeping house when I come up
I think I shall come up there in a week
or ten day if nothing happens. Doctor I must
bid you good day for this time
