DEPARTMENT OF LOUISIANA, New Orleans, La., August 29, 1865.

Hereafter no enlisted man will be sent to General Hospital for the purpose of fixing the responsibility for illegal enlistments under Circular 15, current series, War Department, and General Orders No. 44, current series, Headquarters, Department of the Gulf, until ordered by the Medical Director of the Department of Louisiana.

The certificate of disability will be forwarded as in other cases, and if upon examination the Medical Director is satisfied that the enlistment was illegal, he will order the man to General Hospital for examination and to fix the responsibility for the illegality.
