Canton Nov 6th 1859

Dear Brother

I suppose you will be thinking that I am never going to pay you any more of that Money, but it is not so for I intend to pay you every cent if God spairs my health but the reason I have not sent you more is because they have been stoped for Water the moste part of last Month and have not started yet but am in hopes it will Rain soon if it dont we shall have to go to the poorhouse

While we was stoped I went up to vermont and stayed three Weeks and have been home one and nothing to do I hope you are not in the same mess

How is Joe getting along I hope he is well give him our love tell him to keep a stiff upper lip. Mary joins me in love to you all and hope this will find you all well as this leaves us all enjoying
