

RESEARCH QUESTION


- How did the stigmatization of HIV/AIDS as a gay, predominantly white man's disease impact women?

STATE of HIV in U.S



STIGMA

- Classification of AIDS as: "Gay Plague" ; "Gay Cancer" "GRID- Gay Related Immune Deficiency"
- Public Label of AIDS being a predominately gay white man's disease insinuated everyone else not in that group is 'safe'.
 - "The issue of greatest concern to the stigmatized individual is *acceptance*" (Florom-Smith & De Santis, 2012).
 - Homosexuality and hypersexuality were referred to as and persisted to be the roots of the HIV/AIDS epidemic.

New Pneumonia Linked To Gay Lifestyle

Atlanta, GA - According to the U.S. Public Health Service's Center for Disease Control, five sexually active gay men, two of whom died, were treated between October 1980 and May 1981 for pneumonia caused by the <u>Pneumocystis</u> <u>carni</u> parasite. EVOLUTION OF CDC DEFINITION

Exclusion:

CDC

- 1981: First instance of AIDS called *Pneumocystis Pneumonia*
- 1982: CDC issued their first version of the definition of AIDS, solely related to male symptoms

Inclusion:

- 1993: CDC expanding people at risk to include women and people of color
- Addition of bacterial pneumonia, tuberculosis, and stage III cervical cancer as symptoms

CONCEPT OF VIRTUE

- Criminalization of a women's health status:
 - Inability to negotiate condom use
 - Beaten if they question male partner
 - Blamed if seeking medical advice or testing
- Women could only be either wives, innocent, heterosexual, monogamous or "vectors of disease" (Corea, 1992)
- The Taboo nature of sexuality

WOMEN'S ERASURE


Selection of Women:

- Prostitutes and female IV drug users were the first women to be mentioned and blamed for HIV/AIDS.
 - "The Prostitute Study", San Francisco 1985

False Sense of Security:

- Trapped women in a dangerous narrative
 - heterosexual and virtuous = safe





WOMEN'S ERASURE

Public Exclusion:

- 1983: Dr. Judith Cohen, epidemiologist for Schoolof Public Health in Berkeley, CA, was told "studyingAIDS in women was a waste of time" (Corea, 1992).
- December 1985: CDC advice women to delay pregnancy to avoid fetus transmission
- January 1988: Robert Gould's remarks in Cosmo magazine to the high infection rates within African men "take their women in a brutal way" (Gould 1988, 147).





BLACK WOMEN

- AIDS was never a disease impacted just gay white men, it impacted the black community and women.
 - Katrina Haslip: founder of AIDS Counseling and Education (ACE) and member of ACTUP - "ACT UP's success simply would not have been possible without women like her" (Alder, 2022).
- She touched the lives of HIV-positive women by leading the charge for the CDC to reclassify AIDS.

THE DISPROPORTION EFFECTS

Society's Claim

- Hypersexualization of the black community, especially women
- Bisexual closeted men
- Increased drug use

Social Inequities

- Growing disparity in healthcare access, employment, & housing
- Lack of leadership and organizational resources
- Historic medical and governmental mistrust
- Immediate racial association with disease
- "Low level of knowledge about the prevalence of AIDS among African Americans" (Quinn, 1993)

Further Erasure of Black Women

- 1983 CDC *Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report* depicts the disproportionate effect of AIDS/HIV on the black community:
 - 10-12% of the population made up nearly 20% of AIDS/HIV cases (Cohen, 199)
- In 2021: Black women account for 60% of HIV infections yet made up 15% of the female population. (Ojikutu & Mayer, 2021)





GAINING RECOGNITION

- Black women upheld the role to uplift and lead their community with what is referred to as "black activist mothering" (McLane-Davison, 2016).
- Black women activists combined with the assistance of other organizations and black civil rights movements to advance the cause.
- The lack of overall public AIDS education "seemed to illustrate the predicament of politically voiceless women depending on others who were more organized, better connected, and financially endowed" (Quimby & Samuel, 1989).



ACT UP

- The AIDS Coalition to Unleash Power is a global grassroots political organization dedicated to eradicating the AIDS pandemic.
- Achievements:
 - Persuaded FDA to alter drug approval process to make them accessible
 - 4 year campaign to change CDC definition of AIDS to symptoms that affected only women.
 - Enabled women to participate in experimental drug trials
