JOURNAL OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

Providence, Rhode Island

January 24, 1966

The Convention was called to order by Mr. Dennis J. Roberts, Chairman at 1:48 P.M.

INVOCATION

The Chairman presented Reverend Edmund H. Fitzgerald of the Church of St. Teresa of the Child Jesus, Pawtucket, for the purpose of giving the Invocation. The Invocation was given.
