The subtitle of Gian-Carlo Menotti's comic one-act opera, *The Telephone*, is *L'amour a trois*—"The Love Triangle."

Ben loves Lucy. But he has a seemingly unbeatable rival for Lucy's affections: her telephone! Each time he tries to speak seriously with her, the phone rings. Finally, out of time, and desperate, Ben realizes what it is he must do if he hopes to triumph over this implacable adversary for the hand of his beloved.

Since its premiere in 1947, *The Telephone* has remained a favorite with artists and audiences alike, for its comic libretto (also by the composer), its witty, tuneful music, and especially its accessibility for young singers. The ironic social commentary of the work seems to take on added resonance nowadays in the Age of the Ubiquitous Cell Phone.
