What to look for:

- Vivid blue birds
- white to gray throat to belly area
- gray-blue crest on its head
- black and white bars on wings and tail



Where you'll find them:



From Rhode Island to Texas, to Florida: They are almost in everyone's back yard

Calls and songs:

Loud and noisy, they mimic other birds



What they eat:

Insects, nuts, seeds, and vegetable matter

Where they spend their winters:

Migrate south one year, stay north the next winter and then migrate south again the next year



Fun fact: Bluejays are very intelligent birds. They store food in hiding places to eat later and then easily remember/find where they hid their meal!
