

Caritas in Veritate, Providence College's Theology Journal, Volume 1: Call for Papers

We are pleased to announce the launch of *Caritas in Veritate*, a new online theology journal at Providence College. The mission of *Caritas in Veritate* is to examine Catholic doctrine in a spirit of faithful inquiry, as a response to the Church's call for the New Evangelization. Articles in the journal aim to be both intellectually stimulating and faithful to the Church's magisterium and yet accessible to a wider audience.

Our anticipated first edition will be in the Fall of 2017, publishing papers presented in a Spring 2017 symposium, with the theme of love and truth.

We encourage all undergraduates, graduates and faculty members to submit papers to be included in the first edition.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION: To be considered to present at the symposium, a synopsis of the paper should be submitted to Dr. Daria Spezzano, the faculty advisor for the journal, at: dspezzan@providence.edu by March 3. Authors of papers selected will present at a symposium on April 1, 2017. A final version of the paper will then be considered for publication in *Caritas in Veritate*. For the 2017 symposium we are accepting papers in all areas of Catholic theology, but particularly as pertains to the relationship between truth and love in the larger Christian tradition. We also welcome submission year-round of full-length papers on any theological topic for publication in the journal.
